**LESSONS TO CHRISTIANS WHEN PEOPLE DIE BY REV. ALEX KYOBE**

1. Hope in resurrection; 1Thessalonians 4:13-14, <sup>13</sup> Brothers and sisters, we do not want you to be uninformed about those who sleep in death, so that you do not grieve like the rest of mankind, who have no hope. <sup>14</sup> For we believe that Jesus died and rose again, and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in him. John 11:25-26, <sup>25</sup> Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; <sup>26</sup> and whoever lives by believing in me will never die. Do you believe this?”. We have hope in Jesus' promise of resurrection and eternal life.

2. Life is fleeting; Psalms 90:12, Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom. James 4:14 Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes., Life is short, we should live with purpose and focus on God God's sovereignty; Job 1:21, and said: “Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked I will depart. <sup>12</sup> The LORD gave and the LORD has taken away; may the name of the LORD be praised.” Ecclesiastics 8:8, As no one has power over the wind to contain it, so <sup>12</sup> no one has power over the time of their death. As no one is discharged in time of war, so wickedness will not release those who practice it. God is in control. He gives and takes away

3. Comfort in grief 2Corinthians 1:8-10 <sup>8</sup> We do not want you to be uninformed, brothers and sisters, <sup>9</sup> about the troubles we experienced in the province of Asia. We were under great pressure, far beyond our ability to endure, so that we despaired of life itself. <sup>9</sup> Indeed, we felt we had received the sentence of death. But this happened that we might not rely on ourselves but on God, who raises the dead. <sup>10</sup> He has delivered us from such a deadly peril, and he will deliver us again. On him we have set our hope that he will continue to deliver us, John 14:1-3, “Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God <sup>12</sup>; believe also in me. <sup>2</sup> My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? <sup>3</sup> And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am.. God comforts us in sorrow, reminding us he's with us.

4. Focus on eternal things 2Corinthians 4:17-18, <sup>17</sup> For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. <sup>18</sup> So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal. Mathew 6:19-20, <sup>19</sup> “Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. <sup>20</sup> But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. We focus on eternal life with God not earthly things.

5. Community support. Romans 12:15, <sup>15</sup> Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn 1Thessalonians 5:14, <sup>14</sup> And we urge you, brothers and sisters, warn those who are idle and disruptive, encourage the disheartened, help the weak, be patient with everyone. We support and comfort one another in times of grief.

These lessons help us face death with hope and trust in God.
