LISTENING THE INNER VOICE AS A CHRISTIAN

Our inner voice is a gift from God, its part of our spiritual nature. As Christians we need to listen to the inner voice which involves discerning the Holy spirit's guidance from personal thoughts, often experienced as a 'still small voice' or a 'deep, peaceful knowing'.

It is not a special skill attained through training; No!
It is more like a birthright for believers, sharpened through quiet prayer, scripture study and obedience to God. John10:27 “My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me’

We all have an inner voice but it can be a good or bad thing. When our consciences are left to drift, we can suffer the negativity of the outcome. When our consciences align with the Holy spirit, we get to enjoy the blessing.

Sometimes you need to just stop and listen to the 'still small voice' before you make some of those choices in life, for your family, or business or in ministry; since we face the predicament of the need to make decisions on different aspects of our everyday lifestyle. How to listen to the inner voice.

- Honor God and listen to that voice; you'll not do what you know is wrong. Read the word of God more and obey it, and live it out into action.
- Overlook the wrong done and listen to your positive inner voice. When you dwell on the wrong done to you, you'll end up full of anger. When your thoughts are of love toward your enemies or if they are of hate, endeavour to listen to the one that brings peace. Mathew 5:44 teaches us to love our enemies.
- Do good; When the inner voice says, Do a kind deed. Don't listen to excuses of why you should not do it. It could be just an encouragement to someone. Galatians 6:9 Lets us not become weary in doing good
- Stop the negativity toward yourself; We have two inner voices, the positive one protecting our core values and the negative one that's rooted in fear, insecurity or selfishness. You are responsible for your inner voice regardless of what it says. Jeremiah 29:7, God's thoughts are best for us, they'll guide us.

Take time to listen to your positive inner voice and learn how to control it. It will guide you to becoming a person that's guided by God's spirit with the power of God, with confidence, and a positive christian.
