**Meaning of the hymn per stanza**

Stanza 1: is basically praise that starts with seeing God's power in the world he made. The writer looks at nature; the stars, thunder, and mountains.

Stanza 2: Christ's sacrifice. We move to the cross. Thinking of Jesus' suffering and dying for us bow down. It's gratitude, not just amazement.

Stanza 3: Daily comfort. God isn't far away. He walks with us, talks with us and gives peace when life is hard. It's personal. 'He is mine'

Stanza 4: The song ends looking forward. One day Jesus will return with a trumpet sound, and all we can do is worship. It turns praise into hope.

This hymn takes us from 'wow God' to 'I love you God!' In singing this hymn, we repel the devil through actively focusing the mind on God's sovereignty, Psalms 8; 2 Samuel 7:22, Therefore you are great O' God for there's none like you, and there's no God besides you, according to all that we have heard with our ears; the victory at the cross and hope of Christ's return.
