BIBLICAL ROLES AND PRINCIPLES FOR WOMEN IN A CHRISTIAN WOMEN'S FELLOWSHIP compiled by Rev. Alex Kyobe

In the Bible, women are called, gifted, and used by God in the church and in fellowship with other women. The role isn't about “less” or “more” than men, it's about serving together with the gifts God gives.

Here are the main biblical roles and principles for women in a Christian women's fellowship:

1. To love, encourage, and teach each other: Titus 2:3-5 “Likewise, teach the older women to be reverent in the way they live... Then they can urge the younger women to love their husbands and children, to be self-controlled and pure, to be busy at home, to be kind, and to be subject to their husbands, so that no one will malign the word of God.” Older women mentor younger women. Sharing wisdom about marriage, motherhood, purity, self-control, and godliness. This is the heart of a women's fellowship, discipleship woman-to-woman.

2. To Pray and minister together: Acts 1:14 - The women were with the disciples “all joined together constantly in prayer.”

Acts 16:13 - Paul met with “women who had come together” to pray and listen to God's word by the river.

Pray for one another, carry burdens, worship, and seek God together. James 5:16 “Pray for each other so that you may be healed.”

3. To serve and use spiritual gifts

Romans 16 lists many women serving:

- Phoebe - “a deacon/servant of the church” Romans 16:1
- Priscilla - taught Apollos with her husband Acts 18:26
- Mary, Tryphena, Tryphosa, Persis - “worked hard in the Lord” Romans 16:6,12

- Junia - “outstanding among the apostles” Romans 16:7

1 Peter 4:10 “Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others.”

Teach, host, give, lead, evangelize, care for the sick, counsel, using whatever gifts the Spirit gives.

4. To be an example of Godliness

1 Peter 3:3-4 “Your beauty should not come from outward adornment... but from your inner self, the unfading beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit.”

Titus 2:4-5 - Show younger women how to love God, family, and live with self-control.

Live out the gospel so other women see Christ in you. Matthew 5:16 “Let your light shine before others.”

5. To learn, grow, and submit to God's word

Acts 18:26 - Priscilla and Aquila “explained to Apollos the way of God more accurately.”

Luke 10:39 - Mary “sat at the Lord's feet listening to what he said.” Study the Bible together, ask questions, grow in truth, and apply it. Proverbs 27:17 “As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another.”

What the Bible does NOT say

The Bible doesn't limit women to just “cooking and singing.” At the same time, in the overall church it gives specific guidelines for teaching authority - 1 Timothy 2:11-12, 1 Corinthians 14:34-35. But in a women's fellowship, women teaching other women is clearly modelled in Titus 2 and Acts 18.

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
