What is Parenting/ Guardianship?	It is the process of promoting & supporting the physical, emotional, cognitive, social, and educational development from infancy to adulthood. By Wikipedia	It is a process of raising children (biological & non biological) and providing for them to develop into a true Christian, from infancy through adulthood. And ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord Ephes 6:4
Some principles of parenting. (How?)	<p>-What you do matters. Think before you act. Whatever you do, children will learn and apply it too</p> <p>-Be involved in your child's life. Don't do everything for them but guide, teach and train. It takes time and hard work, so you'll re-think and re-arrange your priorities frequently, but it will be worth it in the end, when your input made a different in their lives.</p> <p>-Each child is unique, so the parenting styles should fit them. The children's development will differ and so will your application of the values, teachings etc for each to benefit from you and to learn</p> <p>-Set rules for them and discipline them appropriately. Begin managing your child's behavior from when they're still young, emphasize the rules set as they grow. Correcting them is meant to help them live or do better but not to torture them. Don't make them feel that you are revenging on them because your upbringing was tough and hard.</p> <p>-Respect and trust the children by giving them opportunities and roles to undertake first in your presence and later in your absence. Hence creating a responsible citizen</p>	<p>-Parents/Guardians need to be exemplary by honoring their father and mother, then the children will learn to honor them too. Honor thy father and thy mother...Deut. 5:16</p> <p>-Be intentional in training up our children under your care, everything they see and hear, they too will utilize it in their adult lives. Train up a child the way he should go... Prov. 22:6</p> <p>-As Parents/Guardians through God's guidance endeavor to keep harmony and peace in a home. He that troubles his own house shall inherit the wind...Prov. 11:29</p> <p>-Always correct and discipline children. Correct thy son, and he shall give thee rest...Prov. 29:17; Prov. 13:24</p> <p>-As believers, we must provide for the needs and wants of our children, physically plus financially, socially, academically, spiritually and morally. But if any provide not for his own and especially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.</p> <p>-Allow your children to learn from you, then they too will pass on the legacy of the values learnt to their children and grandchildren. We will not hide them from their children, shewing to the generation to come the praises of the Lord and His strength and His wonderful works that he hath done Psalms 78: 4</p>

Whether it is fatherhood or motherhood or you are still a child, whatever we choose to do or not to do, and how we do it, will affect our walk with Christ, either positively or negatively. Let's be intentional in living a Christ centered lifestyle.
