Spiritual discernment: Recognize God's voice and distinguish it from other influences. 2. Obedience: Hearing God's voice implies a willingness to obey His commands. 3. Relationship: Belonging to God involves intimacy and communion with Him. 4. Spiritual growth: Hearing God's voice facilitates spiritual maturity and should be portrayed in One’s life. 5. Separation: Christians are distinct from those who don't belong to God. 6. Accountability: Recognize responsibility to heed God's voice. 7. Faithfulness: Trust God's guidance, even when challenging. 8. Spiritual warfare: Be aware of opposing forces seeking to distract from God's voice. 9. Prayer: Engage in consistent, listening prayer. 10. Bible study: Regularly read and meditate on Scripture. To succeed in these implied aspects, we need to seek spiritual guidance and surround ourselves with supportive believers because even hearing God’s voice is a privilege.

Communication is a vital aspect in all relationships; At home, at work, at church, at school/college, etc., generally it's needed whether we acknowledge it or not. Communication is exchanging messages through talking, writing, or body language. We send information, ideas or thoughts between individuals or groups of people; it is received and after understanding it, a response or feedback is given back. (i. e the communication process).



So in general;

- Always maintain contact of the person/people you're communicating to.
- Endeavor to be respectful
- Show enthusiasm, as you tend toward being appreciative and with gratitude.
- Be aware of cultural, age, community or even family differences in the forms of communication that are preferred.
- Avoid distractions when communicating e.g. phones, background noise, etc.

- Be open to learn or to be corrected and to clarify where it's necessary.
- Avoid stereotyped and biased communications.
- Finding common ground; shared goals and interests when communicating is sometimes a given.
