- 1. Spiritual deafness: Gradual inability to hear God's voice.
- 2. Disobedience: Failure to follow God's commands and guidance.
- 3. Strained relationship: Distance and disconnection from God.
- 4. Spiritual stagnation: Lack of growth and maturity.
- 5. Deception: Vulnerability to false teachings and influences and so can easily be misled to doing wrong.
- 6. Sin and rebellion: Continued disobedience leads to sin and rebellion.
- 7. Condemnation: Missing out on God's best, leading to regret.
- 8. Lack of discernment: Inability to distinguish truth from falsehood.
- 9. Spiritual blindness: Ignorance of God's will and purposes.
- 10. Separation from God: Ultimately, not belonging to God, leading to eternal separation (Isaiah 59:2).

Communication is a vital aspect in all relationships; At home, at work, at church, at school/college, etc., generally it's needed whether we acknowledge it or not. Communication is exchanging messages through talking, writing, or body language.
