Subsequently, this can lead to;

1. Spiritual deafness: Gradual inability to hear God's voice.
2. Disobedience: Failure to follow God's commands and guidance.
3. Strained relationship: Distance and disconnection from God.
4. Spiritual stagnation: Lack of growth and maturity.
5. Deception: Vulnerability to false teachings and influences and so can easily be misled to doing wrong.
6. Sin and rebellion: Continued disobedience leads to sin and rebellion.
7. Condemnation: Missing out on God's best, leading to regret.
8. Lack of discernment: Inability to distinguish truth from falsehood.
9. Spiritual blindness: Ignorance of God's will and purposes.
10. Separation from God: Ultimately, not belonging to God, leading to eternal separation (Isaiah 59:2).

**SOME COMMUNIIATION TIPS by Christine Peruth Atuhairwe**

Communication is a vital aspect in all relationships; At home, at work, at church, at school/college, etc., generally it's needed whether we acknowledge it or not. Communication is exchanging messages through talking, writing, or body language. We send information, ideas or thoughts between individuals or groups of people; it is received and after understanding it, a response or feedback is given back. (i. e the communication process).



So in general;

- Always maintain contact of the person/people you're communicating to.

- Finding common ground; shared goals and interests when communicating is sometimes a given.
