Ignorance and Lack of Knowledge</p> <p>Hosea 4:6: "My people are destroyed from lack of knowledge." Ignorance and lack of knowledge can lead to misunderstandings and a lack of love for others.</p> <p>Matthew 22:37-40: "Jesus replied: 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' ... All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." Loving others requires knowledge of God's laws and principles.</p> <p>6. Hardness of Heart</p> <p>Matthew 19:8: "Jesus replied, 'Moses permitted you to divorce your wives because your hearts were hard. But it was not this way from the beginning.'" Hardness of heart can make it difficult for us to love others as God expects.</p> <p>Mark 10:5: "Jesus replied, 'It was because your hearts were hard that Moses wrote you this law.'" Hardness of heart can lead to a lack of love and compassion for others.</p> <p>7. Worldly Influences</p> <p>1 John 2:15-17: "Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father is not in them. For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—comes not from the Father but from the world." Worldly influences can distract us from loving others as God expects.</p> <p>Romans 12:2: "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will." Conforming to the world's patterns can lead to a lack of love for others.</p> <p><i>Only if we accept Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and try to do as He commands, can we then be in position to Love all His people equally.</i></p> </div>

The Bible provides several reasons why we fail to love people equally or as God expects:

1. Sinful Nature

Romans 3:23: "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." Our sinful nature can lead us to prioritize self-interest over loving others.

1 John 1:8: "If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us." Our sinfulness can blind us to our own biases and prejudices.

2. Fear and Self-Protection

1 John 4:18: "There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment." Fear can cause us to withdraw from others and prioritize self-protection over loving them.

Proverbs 10:12: "Hatred stirs up conflict, but love covers over all wrongs." Fear and self-protection can lead to hatred and conflict.

3. Biases and Prejudices

James 2:1-13: "My brothers and sisters, believers in our glorious Lord Jesus Christ must not show favoritism." Biases and prejudices can cause us to favor some people over others.

Romans 2:11: "For God does not show favoritism." God's love is impartial, but our biases and prejudices can lead us to show favoritism.

4. Lack of Empathy and Understanding

1 Peter 3:8: "Finally, all of you, be like-minded, be sympathetic, love one another, be compassionate and humble." Lack of empathy and understanding can make it difficult for us to love others as ourselves.

Philippians 2:3-4: "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others." Valuing others above ourselves requires empathy and understanding.

Only if we accept Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour and make an effort to do as He commands, can we then be in position to Love all His people equally.
