## ▲ A Call to Remember God's Faithfulness in Our Service

"God is not unjust; he will not forget your work and the love you have shown him as you have helped his people and continue to help them." — **Hebrews 6:10 (NIV)** 

On this special day, **Ven. Canon Geofrey Wilson Kakooza** offered a heartfelt message reminding believer of one foundational truth: **God sees, remembers, and rewards faithful service**. Drawing from **Hebrews 6:10**, he encouraged all those in ministry, leadership, and quiet service to take comfort in the character of a just and faithful God.

"God is not unjust; He will not forget your work..."

# A Life of Ongoing Ministry

Service to God is not a one-time act but a **continuous lifestyle**. As the Scripture says, "you have helped His people and continue to help them." The Lord honours not only past efforts but also ongoing faithfulness. Our consistency in loving others, giving, praying, and labouring in the vineyard matters deeply to Him.

Ven. Canon Kakooza urged believers to reflect:

Am I still helping God's people today?

- Do I serve with the same passion I once had?
- Am I allowing God to purify me for greater service?

He concluded with a word of blessing and encouragement:

"May the words you've heard today inspire you to continue as God's servant, as He removes what is unworthy in us so that we may serve Him joyfully. May God protect you, strengthen you, and use you even more for His glory."

What a timely message to stir up faithfulness, perseverance, and joy in our calling. In a world that often forgets or overlooks our efforts, we are reminded that **God never forgets**.

#### Reflection Points:

- How am I actively showing love through service?
- Do I trust that God sees my labour even when others don't?
- What areas of my life do I need God to purify so I can serve Him better?

Let this word be a **reminder**, **encouragement**, **and motivation** to continue running your race with joy, knowing that God's eyes are ever on the faithful.
